- Follow Powder Mill Hollow Road, past Earl Road on left, past Old Powder Mill Road on left.
- Past Hemlock Road on left (You will see lake on left),
- At the end of the guardrail along lake look for stone/macadam driveway to left (Approx. 2 miles from Flying Dog Restaurant)
- If you passed Fancy Hill Road on the right you have gone too far!
- Follow stone drive past back of lake, through the yellow gate up to the Studio
