HOURS: Saturday 9:00 AM - 5:00 PM; Sunday 10:00 AM - 4:00 PM

LOCATION: Kutztown University's Michael O'Pake Field House (formerly Keystone Hall.) This is a large facility with plenty of room on South Campus Drive (corner of Trexler Ave and Baldy St) Kutztown University, Kutztown PA 19530

We will have live music and food service in a café area.

ELIGIBILITY: Participation is for juried members of the Reading-Berks Chapter and PA Guild of Craftsmen. Priority is given to Reading-Berks Guild members. Subsequent applications will be solicited from state juried members, other PGC chapter juried members and invited fine artists. **Application deadline is** October 1, 2017.

SET-UP: Friday, from <u>2:00 PM to 8:00 PM</u> for set-up other than committee. -- With this facility there are six (6) sets of doors to enter for both set-up and tear-down. NOTE: If you are handicapped and need additional assistance please contact the committee before the set-up date.

DOORS OPEN AT 7:00 AM ON SATURDAY for last minute preparation.

BREAKDOWN: SUNDAY <u>begins at 4:00 PM</u>. Violators will jeopardize future acceptance to the show. **SUBMIT PAYMENT AND COMPLETED APPLICATION TO**: Reading-Berks Guild - PGC, P.O. Box 85, Mohnton, PA 19540. <u>Also include a CD or Email biography and photographs for advertising purposes.</u>

BOOTH INFORMATION

- YOU MUST HAVE A 3-SIDED BOOTH. Walls/backdrops must be minimum 6 feet or higher. Booths must have a professional appearance with covered backdrops on 3 sides. (2 sides for corner spaces). Booth structures or materials cannot extend into adjacent spaces or aisles. NO CANOPY TOPS ARE PERMITTED. If you do not have a proper backdrop or booth walls, you will be charged an additional \$75.00 for a 3-sided pipe and drape booth. Please do not scratch or damage the floor with your booth walls or furnishings. If necessary, place a protective covering on the floor.
- **ELECTRICITY**: No additional charge. Electricity is limited to 240 watts per booth. Electricity requirements will be closely monitored and enforced.
- After receiving your application, you will be notified with an acceptance packet.*
- **REFUND POLICY**: Full refund will be honored until September 1. There will be NO refunds after that.
- **RETURNED CHECKS:** There will be a \$25.00 fee on any returned checks.
- *<u>VOLUNTEERS</u>: Reading-Berks chapter's show policy requires all show participants to perform at least one show related task. <u>Participants who are unable to volunteer their time should include the additional \$20.00 non-volunteer fee in their application.</u> All show weekend volunteers will be notified with a schedule in their show packet.
